

FILING PERIOD

The filing period for the November General Election is Monday, July 12, 2010 through Friday, August 6, 2010.

Forms for candidacy are available from the **Office of the Registrar of Voters, at 44 N. San Joaquin Street, 3rd Floor, Suite 350, Stockton, CA 95202. (New Administration Building)**

The candidate should personally file all papers involved with his or her candidacy. A specific letter of authorization, signed by the candidate, is required of any person obtaining or submitting filing documents on behalf of a candidate. Candidates unable to take the "Oath of Office" at the Registrar of Voters' office must do so in front of a Notary Public.

Forms are filed only in the Registrar of Voters' office. Make sure all forms are complete before filing.

Forms are accepted by mail during the filing period – but must be received by 5:00 p.m. on Friday, August 6, 2010, in the Registrar of Voters' office – NO EXCEPTIONS.

EXTENSION – IF INCUMBENT DOES NOT FILE

If the incumbent does not file his or her Declaration of Candidacy with the Registrar of Voters by 5:00 p.m. on August 6, 2010, the filing period is extended until 5:00 p.m. on August 11, 2010 for **non-incumbent candidates only.**
