**ORDINANCE NO. 4319**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE MOUNTAIN HOUSE COMMUNITY SERVICES  
DISTRICT AMENDING WATER SERVICES REGULATIONS AND  
STANDARDS PERTAINING TO DISCONTINUANCE OF WATER SERVICE**

**THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE MOUNTAIN HOUSE COMMUNITY  
SERVICES DISTRICT ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:**

SECTION 1. Section MH-33312 of the Ordinance Code of the Mountain House Community Services District is amended to read as follows:

**Section MH-5-3312: Application for Discontinuance of Water Service**

Application to discontinue water service shall be made to the MHCS D not less than three days before the date on which discontinuance is desired. Such discontinuance may be approved at the discretion of the General Manager, and then, only when it is necessary for construction or repair. After the effective date of such discontinuance, all water consumption and water charges accruing shall cease until a customer requests resumption of water service to a parcel, except that temporary discontinuance of water service for any period of less than six months shall not result in a cessation of monthly fixed or standby charges.

SECTION 2. Section MH-5-3337 of the Ordinance Code of the Mountain House Community Services District is amended to read:

**Section MH-5-3337: Collection of Water Service Charges with Charges for Other Utility and Solid Waste Collection Services**

Water service charges, imposed for water service to a customer, shall be collected together with the charges for any other utility and solid waste collection service rendered to the customer by the District either directly, through contract or permit. Such water service charges shall be billed upon the same bill and collected as one item with such other utility and refuse collection charges, unless other arrangements are approved by the MHCS D General Manager

If all of the bill is not paid within 10 days following its due date, the MHCS D General Manager may order the shut off of any and all utility services for which the bill is

rendered, including but not limited to water, wastewater storm water service and refuse collection service and pursuant to such procedures as may be required in state law.

Shutoff of any utility service shall not result in the cessation of monthly charges for such services.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty (30) days after its adoption, and prior to the expiration of fifteen (15) days from the passage thereof, shall be published once (1) in The Tracy Press, a newspaper of general circulation published in the County of San Joaquin, State of California, with the names of the members of the Board of Directors voting for and against the same.
